The contracting authority will issue a call-off by way of direct award without opening up competition or through the operation of a mini-competition. The call-off contract will be on the terms specified in the Framework Agreement call-off terms and conditions, supplemented as appropriate by such details as price and quantity which will be specified in the call-off order.
