Also attached are reports for evaluation of the site and for mitigation of a doctors' surgery which now fronts onto Station Road.

Bidders will be required to confirm their availability and anticipated timescales for the work on site as part of their proposal. Logistics will need to be carefully managed to avoid spoil double-handling and the site may need to be excavated/backfilled in phases. It should also be noted that the football pitches to the east, in the former quarry footprint, will remain in use whilst the excavation is in progress and so this area cannot be used for welfare or spoil storage.
