Any candidate that receives a fail and or a score of 5 or below based on the scoring methodology will be eliminated from the process at the point where the fail occurs.

Stage Two - All Organisations that successfully pass all elements of the selection stage will progress on to the Award Stage. This stage will be evaluated using the Most Economical Advantageous Tender (MEAT) criterion, structured as Price 20% / Quality 80%
