The Authority intends to enter into a contract for 12 months from 01st April 2024 - 31st March 2025, with an aggregate contract value is forecasted at £1,063,075 to incumbent provider Thurrock Health Hubs.

This contract award notice is made following the Authority's publication of the voluntary ex ante transparency notice (Notice Number: 2023/S 000-037590) on the 21st December 2023 which outlined the rationale and reasoning for the Authority's decision to award this contract, under Regulation 32 (2) (c) of the Public Contract Regulations 2015 ("PCR 2015") (as amended The Public Procurement (Amendment etc.) (EU Exit) Regulations 2020).

The Authority is applying the NHS Standard Contract Terms and Conditions to support a combination of services, all of which are part funded under a single clinical contract, to ensure appropriate clinical governance and service delivery quality as well as consistency of service to patients.

The contract will be for 12 months from 01st April 2024 - 31st March 2025 . The aggregate contract value is forecasted at £1,063,075.
