For the supply of Medical chart paper and ultrasound film which are used in a clinical setting to record and document results for these devices:

Cardiotocography (CTG)

- Monitors foetal heart rate + uterine contractions
- Used in pregnancy/labour to detect foetal distress

Electrocardiogram (ECG)

- Records heart's electrical activity

- Detects arrhythmias, heart attack, rhythm issues

#### Optical (medical)

- Light based imaging (e.g., OCT, endoscopy)
- Provides high resolution views for diagnosis/surgery

#### Foetal monitoring

- Tracks baby's heart vs contractions
- Guides decisions during labour

#### Pulmonary devices

- Spirometer, peak flow, etc.
- Measures lung function for asthma/COPD

#### Bladder scanner

- Portable ultrasound
- Checks bladder volume to avoid unnecessary catheter

#### Urine analyser

- Automated urinalysis
- Detects glucose, protein, infection markers

#### Medical refrigeration

- Special fridge (+2–+8 °C)
- Stores vaccines, meds, blood safely

#### Defibrillator recording paper

- Thermal paper for defib monitors
- Prints ECG/event strips for records

## Ultrasound Paper

- specialized thermal printing paper
- Ultrasound scan results
