As the originators, they understand the processes behind the collection and analysis of the data. They have prepared the report of the pilot survey and published a number of peer-reviewed publications on Intake24. Their work on the surveys has been selected as an example from Newcastle University for the UK Research Excellence Framework. They hold the dataset at present and have capacity to work on this project from Dec 20 to Mar 21. This project will ensure that the data will be publically archived once analysis is complete.
