CMHTP Strategic Steering Board (Surrey and North East Hampshire) is committed to developing sustainable and integrated partnerships with providers from the VCSE sector. Action for Carers entered into the original contract with SABP on 01/10/2023 for an initial term until 31/03/2025. The new co-produced service was implemented as part the national community mental health transformation programme to improve the quality and efficiency of services, through integrated service delivery to better meet the needs of adults (aged 18 years and above) with significant mental health needs.

They are satisfying the original contract, and the new contracting arrangements are not changing considerably.
