The Houses of Parliament intend to appoint a maximum of 6 companies with a proven capability in design and installation of broadcast facilities including within occupied historic listed buildings to a framework agreement for Broadcast Design & Installation Work. The design function will involve using a written specification (provided by the Houses of Parliament) to produce detailed schematics, wiring schedules and physical layouts for broadcast quality video and audio systems. These systems will be required to meet internationally recognised standards. Successful contractors will be required to install such systems in various locations on or associated with the Parliamentary Estate, including the Grade I listed Palace of Westminster.
