This expansion of domestic food waste collections requires the coordinated delivery, to maximise efficiencies and reduce carbon footprint, of all products (i.e. leaflets, wheeled bins, containers and caddies) to dwellings throughout the area featuring:

- 4,625 flat blocks
- 51,978 houses

We are engaging with the supply market early to seek new and innovative ideas and better understand what is possible. This will inform our requirements and promote the planned tender process. Our formal tender process is planned for late 2025 once we have completed market engagement.
