When comparing the Memokath-051 to double J stents, patients found they had a better experience with the Memokath. The Memokath is 100% reversible and causes minimal risk of infection. Memokath system causes Less reflux, less flank pain, and less bladder irritation compared to JJ-catheters, and also fewer hospital admissions needed and fewer stent exchanges needed.
