Explanation:

The Authority intends to place a contract with Royal Orthopaedic Hospital Birmingham (ROH) for the provision of Osseointegration for MoD patients that have had combat related injuries.

In accordance with the Public Procurement (Amendment etc.) (EU Exit) Regulations 2020 (SI 2020/1319) this procurement falls to be regulated under the provisions of the Public Contracts Regulations 2015 as amended (in particular by SI 2020/1319).
