recreation, and social and economic wellbeing.

older people to maintain and develop new skills, prevent social isolation, support inclusion and presence in their local communities and provide a break from caring and support for unpaid carers ensuring they can continue to offer ongoing support. Through feedback from

service users, carers and stakeholders there is drive to move away from a predominantly building based day opportunities approach in favour of a broad scope incorporating assets which provide a range 'community-based support' choices including, but not limited to:

- Building based opportunities for those with the most complex support needs
- Short term enablement and skills development
- Centres providing a base for multiple activities with in-reach and outreach to the local community
- Education / training
- Preparation for employment
