Scope

Description

NHS Blood and Transplant (NHSBT) intends to engage with the market to inform the future procurement of plasmapheresis collection systems and associated services. NHSBT is responsible for collecting and producing Plasma for Medicine (PfM) for fractionation into plasma?derived medicinal products for UK patients and is seeking to expand its current plasmapheresis capacity beyond its existing three donor centres.
