- assess overall social care data maturity.
- assess local authority readiness for the NDR programme.
- make recommendations for improvement for the individual local authority, and for the NDR programme.
- b) a discovery exercise with local authorities to determine:
- the information they would wish to share with partners in health and other social services providers
- the health information they see as critical in being able to provide the care and support required by the people of Wales.

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c) options and recommendations for developing a standardised approach to social care

data in Wales, which considers the current and future digital landscape and policy

direction of health and care delivery in Wales.
