Any system will need to facilitate compliance with the Renting Homes Act (Wales) 2016 and its associated landlord obligations.

This pre-market engagement exercise will be used to assist Bangor University in gaining a better understanding of the feasibility of the requirements, the most appropriate procurement and operational approach, the capacity of the market to deliver the requirements and an opportunity for the market to highlight any possible risks or issues that may not have previously been considered.
