and the delivery of specialist public health services. UKHSA is an operationally autonomous

executive agency of the United Kingdom Department of Health and Social Care (DHSC).

UKHSA is seeking to partner with a supplier who can support the delivery of UKHSA objectives

across South East Asia. UKHSA's International Health Regulations (IHR) Strengthening Project is enhancing global health security by strengthening the capability and capacity of public health institutions in Africa and Asia to comply with the WHO IHR (2005) to prevent, detect and respond to public health threats such as COVID. Project is working with regional bodies across South East Asia, including The Association of
