-Allows East Coast Pathology Network to progress with plans at an accelerated rate due to the certainty around the contracts in the acute.

- Retains the service within the acute trusts which will mitigate the risk of the following:
- Realisation of exit costs which would be payable if the service were to move away from the acute trusts
- Duplication of services if elements were to be split
- Retains scarce pathology human resource within one service and prevents duplication of roles
- Prevents disaggregation of IT and records
- Realisation of unknown risks
