This Prior Information Notice is to signal an intention to commence market engagement with those within the energy market.

Crown Commercial Service (CCS), as the Contracting Authority, intends to put in place a framework agreement for the supply of approximately 23 TWh of electricity and gas to meet requirements of 820 customers across c.73,000 meters managed via an aggregated, flexible, risk managed approach.

The requirement covers all gas and electricity meters.
