The ITT was conducted as an 'OPEN' single stage process. The authority elected to follow the open procedure for this procurement exercise as per regulation 27 of the Public Contract Regulations 2015. discrimination.

The authority established a framework which will be for the hire of complete, same sex wards, generally for a minimum period of six (6) months and up to four (4) years and for the 'spot purchase' of individual beds for short term periods.
