The service will provide assessments, maintenance and repairs as required and associated education delivered at home, within clinical settings or within venues agreed by the service users.

The key objectives of this service are:

- High patient, carer and referrer satisfaction
- The patient will be provided with the necessary and appropriate equipment to meet their clinical needs, in line with the service specification

- Prevent hospital admission and facilitate early discharge
