Arc Partnership required a Bidder to provide Legionella Monitoring at various locations, predominantly across Nottinghamshire, but also a few locations across Derbyshire, South Yorkshire and Leicestershire, at its client's properties as was listed in the tender documents. The work comprise, Legionella Monitoring and the estimated gross project values generated prior to award were equivalent to £362,050 over the past four years therefore an average of£90,512 per year. The Framework was therefore to be regarded as a speculative venture and no guarantee of work was given by Arc. Bidders had to form their own views as to the potential of the arrangement. One Bidder was appointed for the provision of Legionella Monitoring. The minimum turnover requirement was £181,000 GBP per annum.
