A scheme key to the ambitions of the Sheffield Children's NHS Foundation Trust, as an international centre of excellence the NCCHT will attract inward investment, support growth in the life sciences sector and attract the best talent in the world by creating high-value jobs. The aim is for the NCCHT to position the UK as a global leader in children's health by developing the most advanced children's healthcare system in the world.
