The DPS agreement is for the supply of food to go and Retail Café Concepts including but not limited to patient feeding; sandwiches, salads, soups and snack pots, For retail outlets; Sandwiches, Salads, Pasties, Sandwich Fillings, Snack pots, cakes, pastries, street food, soups, confectionery, snacks, drinks. The DPS is anticipated to be in place for 6 years.

The purpose of this notice is to draw attention to a procurement that NHS Supply Chain intends to commence during the subsequent 12 months. The DPS is divided into Categories and applicants may apply to be included on any or all of the product lots.
