The schools are situated on the same site and provide education to children aged from 2-11. The schools are a happy place, where every child is encouraged to 'Believe and Achieve'. It's a large organisation, with over 642 pupils and around 98 staff. In recent years, pupil numbers have grown and are expected to increase. Food is a central influence on health and wellbeing, and it is crucial for children's development. School food must be tasty, nourishing and meet the dietary needs of all children, whilst remaining accessible to all. It is the intent of the school to offer a good value meal service to pupils and staff. Within the constraints of the meal price the Tenderer shall be required to provide a good quality, nutritionally balanced meal for the children, through an efficient service with a good standard of presentation and a menu that meets the varying dietary needs of the nationalities of the children. Service should be personal and responsive to a Silver Food for Life standard. An unlimited salad bar option would be welcomed.
