The OPCC will work collaboratively with the successful provider to test innovative ways to improve the lives of victims of stalking. The service must be accessible to all victims of stalking and the OPCC wishes to ensure quality service delivery through the provision of trained and accredited independent advocates, who have appropriate clinical supervision and support to minimise the risk of burn out.
