Key Criteria 2. Value - weighting reflective value for money against available service provision budget/funding.

Key Criteria 3. Integration, collaboration and service sustainability - weighting reflective the aims of the service provision to support integration and collaboration with wider health and care system.

Key Criteria 4. Improving Access, reducing health inequalities and facilitating - weighting reflected the nature of the service provision linked a specific cohort of the population.

Key Criteria 5. Social Value - weighting has to be 10%

Following a robust assessment process against the documented Basic Selection Criteria and Key Criteria, NHS Humber and North Yorkshire ICB was able identify a provider to be awarded a contract for the Vulnerable Women Health Service (Hull)
