This modification is necessary to meet the additional demands of the Scottish Health and Social Care sector to maintain necessary supply due to circumstances unforeseen by the Authority after the Covid-19 pandemic (and recovery of services), the need to maintain necessary supply and remove unnecessary disruption from the Authority at this time have rendered this modification necessary, in line with Regulation 72(1)(c) of the Public Contracts (Scotland) Regulations 2015.
