The practice provides essential and enhanced primary medical services to 1,098 registered patients (weighted list size 1131.05).

The ICB has received formal notification from the GP Partners that they intend to hand back their contract to the ICB on the 31st July 2025 following a decision by one of the partners to retire from General Medical Practice.
