North and Mid Hampshire ICP is seeking the views of Healthcare Providers in relation to a new Community Diabetes Service North Mid Hampshire (covering Basingstoke, Winchester, Andover and their rural surroundings).

In the North and Mid Hampshire area, there are approximately 21,000 people living with diabetes, which includes approximately 19,000 patients with Type 2 diabetes. From prevalence figures, we estimate that a further 10,000 people (based on 6.73% CCG prevalence), have yet to be diagnosed. The prevalence of diabetes is increasing at about 8% per annum in the under 75 age group.

The anticipated value of the Service is GBP £500,000 per annum.

This is a process designed to help the Commissioner form a view of the best way to commission the service and is not the beginning of a Tender exercise. A draft copy of the specification is embedded in the RFI document and can be accessed via our eTendering
