- to understand how the patient experiences healthcare, and how the processes and systems of delivering care can be improved

For these reasons, leadership and management training is an essential component of the training curricular for all Specialty Schools and junior doctors are required to complete a course in the later part of their training, before they achieve their Certificate of Completion of Training.
