The radiators are required to ensure the engine and transmission temperatures of the vehicles are kept within their commended operating ranges by increasing cooling performance. A total of 596 main engine radiators are required, which must be manufactured to meet the Authority's technical specification and delivered in accordance with a specified delivery schedule.
