Border is a professional law enforcement command within the Home Office. This is achieved through the proactive border protection activities carried out by our staff at all ports of entry.

The required services are for ongoing planned and reactive maintenance, including calibration services, and training for multi-gas monitors (capable of detecting CO, H<sub>2</sub>S, O<sub>2</sub>, and LEL), bump stations, and related equipment in service across the estate
