In accordance with The Health Care Services (Provider Selection Regime) Regulations 2023, Regulation 13 and Schedule 12.

Variation of the contract for Drug and Alcohol Treatment and Recovery Services with Nacro of Walkden House, 16-17 Devonshire Square, London, England, EC2M 4SQ for

the duration of one year from 1 April 2024 to 31 March 2025, for a variation value of £1,704,958. The grant funding (Supplemental Substance Misuse Treatment and Recovery Grant) has been allocated to local areas to address the aims of the treatment and recovery section of the UK Government's 2021 drug strategy. This brings the cumulative change in the lifetime value of the contract to 14.2%.
