NHS Derby and Derbyshire ICB commissions an adult (18+) direct access community audiology service. This service provides hearing assessments and, if necessary, the supply and fitting of one or two hearing aids along with follow-up support. Patients 55 and older can

self-refer, whereas those younger than 55 require a GP referral. In the 2022/23 period, it delivered roughly 55,500 interventions.

The purpose of this advert is to help facilitate engagement with the market to support the commissioner develop its commissioning and procurement strategy for this service.
