Clearance of Overturned Vehicles – a 2-day course (Wednesday to Thursday, currently week 4 of TO Foundation) focused on the requirements of clearing overturned vehicles.

Off Road Coaching Course – a 3-day course to support the accreditation of Off-Road Coaches.
