-High Liability Combat Boots: this is the designated boot for high intensity combat tasks.

Male full sizes 5 to 15, Female full sizes 3 to 9, 2 width fittings medium and large. (UK sizes).

-Patrol Boots: Typically worn in and around the barracks, the range and for driving. Is able to be polished to a parade standard. Male full sizes 5 to 15, Female full sizes 3 to 9, 2 width fittings medium and large. (UK sizes).

-High Liability Desert Combat Boots: this is the designated boot for high intensity combat tasks in hot climates. Male full sizes 5 to 15, Female full sizes 3 to 9, 2 width fittings medium and large. (UK sizes).

-Cold Wet Weather Boot: the operational boot for cold and wet conditions down to -19c. Male full sizes 5 to 15, Female full sizes 3 to 9, 2 width fittings medium and large. (UK sizes).

-Jungle Combat Boots: used for a range of duties, in jungle conditions. Unisex full sizes 3 to 15, 2 width fittings medium and large. (UK sizes).

-Options/solutions for outsizes: Size 16+ (UK sizes).

-Spacers/footbed/insock: To be provided per pair facilitating optimal fit.
