Kent County Council (the Council) is the largest local authority in England covering an area of 3,500 square kilometers. It has an annual expenditure of over £1bn on goods and

Arboricultural maintenance:

- -Removal of dead/diseased and dying trees
- -Ash dieback remedial works
- -Removal of deadwood/ivy/climbing plants/foreign objects
- -Undertaking and repeating crown reduction/annual programmed pollarding works
- -Annual basal and epicormic programmed works.
- -Tree planting and young tree establishment maintenance weeding, watering, and mulch
- -Ad-hoc works relating to the highway soft estate management, tree safety audits and response to customer enquiries.
