The service will provide long term provision, up to a maximum of 2 years between the young people's 16th and 18th birthdays. The provider will oversee the young people's development into adulthood, adopting a light-touch approach to facilitate them at all times to act independently, while monitoring attendance at college, appointments and other community-based activities.
