The NCA programme will be undertaken between 2023 and 2025. In addition to the data capture solution, the department intends to procure a number of surveying organisations ('SOs') to undertake the data collection itself. This notice relates to the procurement of the cloud bases SaaS software solution to support data capture (the "IT Solution").

The IT Solution supplier will be required to work together with the aforementioned SOs on the NCA programme. It is anticipated that the IT solution will be procured first and we wish to test our current thinking with the market.
