The Royal Orthopaedic Hospital NHS Foundation Trust (“the Authority”) is seeking to engage with suppliers interested in its upcoming requirement for a Learning Management System.

The Royal Orthopaedic Hospital (ROH) has been looking to explore options to replace the current Learning Management system (and associated add ons) to the current LMS provision within the ESR System.
