This DPS Agreement is for an initial period of 3 years (up to 31st March 2022) with an option to extend for a further period of up to 2 years, taking the total contract term to a maximum of 5 years and has currently been extended to Sunday 31st March 2024. Any extension will be agreed between the Council and the Provider(s). The deadline for completed applications within "Round 11" to be received on the In-tend eTendering Portal is 12:00noon on Thursday 13th July 2023.
