The Contractor shall provide the full Primary and Occupational health services service to Service personnel for both registered and temporary registered personnel under the entitlement to care (Guidance Number 8) within the DPHC Handbook at the Medical Centre at MOD Abbey Wood . The Contractor's personnel have clinical responsibility for the patients they see and treat. Services are to include:

- a. Acute, urgent, and routine Primary Care, including management of minor injuries and minor illnesses and referral on to secondary care where required in accordance with the NICE guidance and local secondary care referral protocols i.e for potential cancer diagnosis this would be within 1 day of the consultation to enable the 2 week wait process to proceed.
- b. Referral to DPHC intermediate services (mental health, rehabilitation, and occupational health) in line with DPHC Handbooks Vol 5 – Occupational Health, Vol 6 – Rehabilitation and Vol 7 – Mental Health
- c. OH including Service medicals and hearing conservation
- d. Preventative Health Services to include public health immunisation and screening
- e. NHS Screening programmes
- f. Chronic Disease Management
- g. Health Promotion
