Surrey County Council (SCC) has a statutory duty to support disabled children, young people and their families. Personal Support is part of the short breaks offer but is a specialist service and is only available following assessment.

Personal Support is home-based care, primarily used by SCC's Children with Disabilities team to provide families with respite care (short break), in accordance with their assessed needs. Personal support may also be used to provide other types of support such as

emergency or crisis support and support outside the home for children and young people to access and be included in social and leisure actives in their local communities.

The purpose of this event will be to:

Share with you our vision and priorities for the development of Personal Support provision in Surrey.

Learn together about what is working well and what we can improve in how we commission and deliver Personal Support Provision in Surrey.
