The Kent and Medway Wheelchair Service provides buggies, manual and powered wheelchairs, pressure relieving cushions and custom-made seating systems to meet the clinical needs of children, young people and adults with a long term (over six months) disability or illness to enable them to become independently mobile. Referrals into the service come from any registered health care professional or existing wheelchair service users can self-refer.

The contract duration is expected to be 5 years with up to a 2-year extension option. The indicative total contract value (over 7 years) against anticipated activity trajectories is expected to be approximately £39million.

The commissioner has published this Prior Information Notice to support pre-market engagement only at this stage.

The objective of this engagement is to help the commissioner finalise the financial model, service model and procurement strategy.
