The works will provide a segregated cycle facility on both sides along Manchester Road from the Metrolink bridge south to the junction with Wilbraham Road (Four Banks) & Barlow Moor Road from Four Banks to Sandy Lane junction. The proposed measures include:

Side roads:

- marked cycle lanes, with coloured surfacing and cycle symbols.
- enhanced pedestrian crossing points, including tactile paving.
- tightening of radii at junctions to reduce entry/exit speeds through the junction and reducing

pedestrian crossing distances.

- traffic calming features in the form of a road humps.
- Provision of loading bays and disabled parking bays. Locations will be subject to discussions with local business and funding.
