The access bridge to the marina also needs to be refurbished, this will also need to be taken off site for blasting and minor metal works. Temporary access will need to be put in place while the bridge is being refurbished.

Whilst Part 5 Pricing Submission does not need to follow the structure set the information provided must be capable of being assessed against the stated criteria. The full scope of the proposal, including costings and implementation details must be submitted in accordance with the terms set out in these tender documents.
