This relates to the variation of an existing contract. Proposed cost increases to the existing contract are attributable to the on-going increasing costs associated with transport and processing (eg fuel, particularly the move from red to white diesel, energy and staffing) which have been fuelled by not only Brexit and economies restarting following Covid but also the more recent increase in National Insurance costs. The Russia/Ukraine war has also exacerbated fuel and energy costs on a global level.

Due to the current uncertainty and volatility around fuel and energy costs an extension of 6 months has been proposed. As the contract exit date will be 11 November 2023 further extensions under the contract are available to the Council. The council are content that the proposed increased rates still represent value for money in terms of the original procurement. It is reasonable to assume that contractors would not have foreseen the current cost increases in delivering services under the contract at time of tendering.
