- Engaging with communities in some of the most disadvantaged areas of the country to challenge engrained cultural attitudes towards keeping girls and children with disability in school and healthy, connect adolescent girls with sexual and reproductive health services, and support the provision of safe spaces.
- Strengthening systems to improve teaching and learning, reduce violence in schools, deliver alternative services for girls who are out of school, manage public finances better, and provide comprehensive reproductive and sexuality education.
- Developing policies to reform the curriculum to make it more inclusive, increase the supply of qualified teachers in rural areas, and help the education system to respond to shocks such as Ebola and Covid-19 . mobilising rural communities to demand access to health and education services, hold schools and health centres to account, and keep girls and those with disabilities in school.
