The Service is to provide caretaking GP Services from the Northern Medical Centre at Holloway Community Health Centre, 11 Hornsey Street, London N7 8GG.

The contract is to be awarded to the existing provider following a Direct Award Process C.

The term of the contract is from 1st May 2025 to 31st March 2026.

The approximate value of the contract over the 11-month term is £1197271.

The 11-month extension will be on the existing terms (subject to global sum uplift): $\pounds 109.34^*$ per weighted patient (pwp) plus a caretaking premium of $\pounds 20.00$ pwp and $\pounds 5,000$ pcm management fee, therefore approximately $\pounds 125.56$ pwp (for the proposed 11m caretaking period)

e has a mandatory minimum 10% allocation whichwas determined to be sufficient for this contract.

Rationale for choosing the provider: The provider was assessed both for their current performance and potential future performance and provided evaluators with confidence in their ability to meet the requirements of future contract.

In addition to the key criteria, the basic selection criteria used was Pass/ Fail and the provider 'passed' across all areas.
