Wakefield Council is looking to develop a Pseudo Dynamic Purchasing System (Pseudo DPS) for the provision of a generic domiciliary care service and emergency support to carers service

The Council will be seeking applications from suitably qualified and experienced organisations / companies evidencing that they meet the requirements for registration and competency to deliver these services within the Wakefield District.

Providers will be required to operate electronic call monitoring systems for delivering services to account for actual service delivery and to provide specified performance indicators. Payments for Services will be at the Council's fixed Contracted Rate for Care.

It is anticipated that the PDPS will operate initially for the period October 2022 –March 2024, with an option to terminate or to extend for up to a further 1 year (at the Council's sole discretion) i.e., April 2024 - to March 2025.
